# PLANTS OF INTEREST

Colin and Hazel Barker's plant of *Rlc*. Waianae Leopard 'Ching Hua HCC/AOS X *Rth*. Jungle Treasure 'Mojave' HCC/AOS was purchased from Rosella Orchids about four years ago. It was awarded Judges Choice at ROS, EDOS and BOS March meetings. Also, it was considered for a culture award at BOS because it is so well grown. This cross was registered in 2010 as *Rhyncattleanthe* Jungle Jumbalaya. In 2014 *Rth*. Jungle Jumbalaya 'Angela Lee' was awarded an HCC/AOC with 79.5 points and an AD/AOC with 79.6 points.

There is currently a fascination with spotted Cattleyas among some orchid growers and in this crossing this has been achieved using parents with 25% *C. aclandiae* in the case of Jungle Treasure and 50% *C. guttata* in Waianiae Leopard .

To me this is a fine example of one such spotted cattleya. It is immediately eye catching in the way it holds its inflorescence high above its foliage and from a judging perspective the flowers are well arranged and of good shape. Colin & Hazel's Jungle Jumbalaya is a very pleasing pink with very attractive fuchsia spotting and fuchsia splayed lip while the awarded clone is yellow/orange with greyed purple markings and a more fuller lip.
