#### Handy Hints – Sterilising Solution

Last month there was a discussion about sodium orthophosphate and trisodium phosphate.

Ortho phosphoric acid is  $H_3$   $PO_4$  and it gives rise to salts when metals replace the H. In sodium's case  $Na_3$   $PO_4$  is called sodium orthophosphate. Orchidaceous Supplies sells this as Tri sodium phosphate as a solid. The sanitising solution of this is quite concentrated. Cutting instruments should be immersed in that solution for 20-30 minutes before reuse. The solution does not corrode the cutting instruments, and this makes it a favoured sanitiser for many growers, who leave their cutting instruments all the time.

The solution should not be held in P.E.T. containers as it reacts with the plastic.

#### Cultural Notes

#### Bulbophyllum makoyanum

This species is normally found growing on trunks and branches of trees in dappled sunlight.

I found this plant on the EDOS sales table about 4-5 years ago. It was not in the best of health but at \$15.00 I thought it was worth trying to bring it back to life and luckily it has thrived under my conditions which are 75% shade cloth and open to all weather. It's growing in a shallow saucer in my normal  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$  mix of bark, perlite and coconut chip, watered every day and fertilised once a week. I never do any preventative spraying. If I get a problem I treat that individual plant.

Today it has 14 spikes in flower with at least that many yet to develop. It is a very rewarding plant to have in your collection. I would say this plant has had over 100 flower spikes over the last 6 months.

If you find a plant for sale I would suggest buying it, remember to keep it moist to the point of it growing moss on or in the pot-mount as this is its natural habitat and it will reward you with flowers for years to come.
