Plant Labels - It is very important when benching plants that labels are easy to read. A clearly written label makes it much easier for everyone to read, and avoids the possibility of a plant being given an incorrect name on the Prize Cards and in Competition Results. For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct **before** benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have available on Friday night prior to benching of plants, the Orchidwiz database for members to check their labels. Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone.

Member Number - Your Member Number is on the newsletter envelope following your name, or available from the Plant Registrar. This number needs to be used if you are benching and/or selling plants.

Show Attendance Register - It is E.D.O.S Inc. policy that **ALL** persons attending; exhibiting; benching or selling orchid plants at the Autumn Show sign the E.D.O.S Inc. Attendance Register, so please make sure you sign when you arrive at the Hall.

Attendance Book – for Insurance Purposes it is necessary for Members to sign the Attendance Book when helping out at the Show

Cut Flowers and Greenery – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, especially on Saturday, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements.

Condition of Sale Plants – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and NOT recently potted. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc. If it is not a plant in the condition you would consider purchasing yourself, then please do not put it up for sale!

It has been noted that some plants presented for Sale at recent EDOS Shows were below the standard and quality that this Society considers acceptable. If a plant is not of the standard that you yourself would purchase, then it should not be presented to Plant Sales

As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables

Cultural Award for July 14

Oncidium Gold Dust

This plant was a gift from a friend in July 2013. It was then in flower and its bright yellow blooms with a gold centre was absolutely stunning. The plant was repotted in September 2013 into a mix of 1/3 Tref, 1/3 perlite and 1/3 coolite and has since come along in leaps and bounds.

Fertilizing regime has been HSO12 and Seasol once per week. Water was once per week in summer and in

the cooler months only every second or third week. It is housed with all my other orchids under 75% green shadecloth with solarweave, on a waist high bench on the northern end of the shadehouse.

Plant of the Month for July 14

Phragmipedium Green Hornet (longifolium x pearcei)

This is a great little plant with similar appearance to 'pearcei' and loves water as you would expect. pearcei which grows on river banks and is completely submerged in times of flood even clinging to rocks in the middle of the river, one theory is it has developed the very narrow leaves to reduce the effect of the water flowing over it in times of flood.

This plant grows under 2 layers of green shade cloth on the roof and 1 layer on the side. It is watered daily in summer and twice a week in winter, during the warmer months it also sits in a shallow saucer of water.

The mix is $\frac{1}{3}$ small bark, $\frac{1}{3}$ jumbo perlite, $\frac{1}{3}$ small coconut chips. Fertilising is once a week.

This cross is a rapid grower and quickly develops into a specimen size plant with numerous flower spikes and being a sequential flowerer it is in bloom for months at a time.
