## 52nd EDOS SPRING SHOW

15& 16 September, 2018

A reminder that our Spring Show is only a few weeks away. It will be held on 15 and 16 September, 2018, with judging on Friday night 14 September, 2018, so it is now a good time to start preparing your plants, and to consider how you may be able to help out.

DON'T FORGET THAT WE WILL BE AT OUR NEW VENUE – 1485 OLD CLEVELAND ROAD, BELMONT in the Brisbane International Shooting Centre building. There will be plenty of signs to direct everyone to the right place. We have an amazing amount of room, so there will be room for more plants and more Plant Sales area.

Please do not judge your plants at home. Remember that the purpose of our Show is to showcase our Orchids to the public. The more plants we have on the Show bench, the more spectacular it looks to the public.

**Show Roster** - If you are available to **help out** at the Spring Show please put your name in the **Show Roster book** at the next meeting, or contact either Ray, Milton or Barry and let them know when you would be available to help out, and what job you be able to volunteer for.

Even if you can only spare a couple of hours, we need as many members as possible to help make the show a success, and to share the load, so please put your name on the roster!

It's also an opportunity to spend time getting to know other members – for our new members it is an excellent opportunity to learn from our more experienced growers.

Catering - Our Show Catering Convenor Margaret would appreciate any donations of cakes, slices and cookies etc. Margaret will also appreciate assistance in the kitchen, especially during the busy times of the day.

Plant Sales – Our Plant Sales Convenor Dick Dorham is looking for assistance in Plant Sales. If you are available to help out, please either see Dick or a Committee member, or put your name on the Roster.

**Benching Tags** — will be available at the August meetings from Secretary Milton. They are also available for printing from the EDOS Inc Website — www.edos.org.au

Plant Sales Bar Code Labels – Please ensure that you have you Sales Plants labelled correctly with the EDOS Inc Bar Code Labels which need to be ordered from Ray Girdlestone in plenty of time prior to the Show. Labels on small pots need to be placed vertically so that the Bar code Label reader can work properly.

Craft Tags – Craft Tags will be available at the August EDOS meeting. If you are unable to collect them at the meeting please contact Secretary Milton.

Plant Labels - It is very important when benching plants that labels are easy to read and correct. A clearly written label makes it much easier for everyone to read, and avoids the possibility of a plant being given an incorrect name on the Prize Cards and in Competition Results, or even placed in the incorrect category. For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct before benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have available on Friday night prior to benching of plants, the Orchidwiz database for members to check their labels. Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone.

**Member Number** – If you are unsure of your Member Number, please speak to either Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone. This number needs to be used if you are benching and/or selling plants.

**Show Attendance Register -** – It is EDOS Inc. policy that **ALL** persons attending; exhibiting; benching or selling orchid plants at the Spring Show sign the EDOS Inc. Attendance Register, so please make sure you sign when you arrive at the Hall.

**Attendance Book** – for Insurance Purposes it is necessary for Members to sign the Attendance Book EACH DAY when helping out at the Show

Cut Flowers and Greenery – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, especially on Saturday, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements.

Many thanks in advance to all who help us out. If in doubt please ask Brent Nicoll.

**Condition of Sale Plants** – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and NOT recently potted. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc. If it is not a plant in the condition you would consider purchasing yourself, then please do not put it up for sale!

As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS Inc By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables.

**Show Schedule** - A copy of the Schedule for the 2018 Spring Show is attached to this Newsletter, and is also available through the EDOS Inc website.

PLEASE NOTE: There have been some changes made to the Show Schedule and General Conditions, so please have a read of these to ensure that you are aware of any changes that have been made. One change in particular is the number of Champion categories. We have now included a Champion Novice category, and have removed the Floral Art Categories.

Another change in the programme is that JUDGING WILL NOW TAKE PLACE AT 7.30 PM, so Entries MUST be tabled and available for Judging by 7.00 pm

Remember, it will be a requirement to have these barcode labels on your pots, as this is the only method our Plant Sales Staff will be using to process the sale of your plants. You can still put the "old style" information Tags on your plants with whatever information you want eg species, colour etc.

WE ASK THAT MEMBERS PLEASE FILL OUT THIS FORM AS SOON AS IS PRACTICABLE, AND RETURN TO RAY GIRDLESTONE, EITHER BY EMAIL OR AT A MEETING. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE, AS THESE TAKE TIME TO PRINT AND RETURN TO YOU.

The contact details on the form are Important, so that Ray can contact the member if there is an issue, or to let the member know when they are ready for collection.

The most important information required is the number of labels required for each dollar value. Any labels you do not use for the Spring Show can be used at any EDOS Inc show in the future.

## Plants Worth Noting

There were many lovely orchids displayed at our meeting however one that always catches my eye – at shows as well as at our meetings – is *Epc.* Rene Marques 'Flame Thrower' HCC/AOS. This is a hybrid of *Epidendrum pseudepidendrum* and *Cattleya* Claesiana.

The plant displayed at our meeting was approx 800cm tall and had five flowers on a single spike. The flowers had three bright colours - the sepals and petals were sage green, the flower column was green and magenta, and the lip was bright yellow. The colours are quite a contrast but in my mind work well together.

When I first got into Orchids the slipper orchids did nothing for me. However with a little experience and a lot less knowledge they have earned a place in the shade house and my interest. Phragmipedium Green Hornet (=phrag. longifolium X phrag. pearcei) to me is what it is all about. I live in hope that my modest collection of slippers will be able to compete with the likes of this plant.in years to come. Well done, that man.

## Cultural Notes July 18

#### Cymbidium Bedivere

**Cymbidium** Bedivere is a hybrid cross between *Cym. floribundum* and *Cym.* Blue Smoke.

It is made up of *Cym. floribundum 50%, Cym. lowianum* 30% and the other 20% is made up of *Cym. insigne, sanderae* and other. According to OrchidWiz it was first crossed way back in 1963.

It is a really worthwhile Cymbidium to grow and easy to flower.

I say this because, we have great difficulty flowering most of our other Cymbidiums in our area of Caloundra, but much to our delight (and amazement) Cym. Bedivere has flowered well for us for the past few years. This year with14 spikes.

It has lived for the past 3 years hanging, in the corner of our pool garden, where it receives ample humidity from the pool. It's in amongst other foliage plants, where it grows in semi shade and receives full sun in the late afternoon.

It is surrounded by brick walls on 2 sides, the other 2 side are open to the elements.

It seems happy here and almost thrives on neglect as we usually don't notice it flowering until it is well and truly in flower. It is watered and fertilised regularly along with our other orchids, using Horticultural Solutions and organic fertilisers.
