CULTURAL NOTES FROM NOVEMBER MEETING

PHRAGMIPEDIUM GIGANTEUM

Phrag. Giganteum is one of the largest Phrags you are likely to see, not surprisingly with parents of Grande 4N x caudatum they have produced a classic flower with a huge dorsal, very large pouch and long petals. This plant is a relatively easy plant to grow and produces a stunning display every year, this year it has produced 3 inflorescences with a total of 7 flowers. The plant sits in a dome shaped greenhouse open to all weather in a mix of ½ bark, ½ perlite, ½ coconut chip, watered daily and fertilised weekly and sits in a saucer of water during the warmer months.

Sourcing these plants is always a challenge, you can buy flasks which are the most economical way but the down side is the time aspect or you can buy a division if you can find one and they can be rather expensive, but very rewarding as they always put on a fantastic display making the task worth the effort.
