Tony grows his plant high in his orchid house receiving as much sun ,wind and rain as possible. He waters twice a week and fertilizes once a week.

He also tells me that lack of water makes the pseudo bulbs become thin and if too much water is given the bulbs can split, either killing the plant or ruining the prospect of good inflorescences. They don't mind it cold or wet but not cold and wet together. He grows his in coarse bark and perlite giving good drainage.

Well done Tony, a well presented plant.
