All plants offered for sale shall be well established, clean and free from pests and diseases.

Remember that all Plants, either exhibited or in Plant Sales must comply with the Fire Ant Legislation, details for which will be in the next Newsletter.

For any new members, Eric Locke will be doing a presentation on Preparations for a Show at our March Red Spotters.

## Labelling of Plants

It is very important that when benching plants, either at a Monthly Meeting or at a Show, that labels are easy to read. A clearly written label makes it much easier for everyone to read, and avoids the possibility of a plant being given an incorrect name in Competition Results. If you are unsure of the correctness of any of your labels, EDOS has Orchidwiz available at Monthly Meetings and Shows for any member to check the names of plants.

## Cultural Award

Dendrobium bracteosum Rchb.f.

Owned by W & M Williams

This epiphyte is from the lowlands of New Guinea and islands to the east. The large floral bracts are a distinctive feature for which D bracteosum is named. It has erect or pendulous terete to spindle shaped slender green to yellow-green stems approx 50cm long. The flowers are variable in colour lasting for up to 6 months. This species requires bright light and regular watering, but will tolerate dry spells.

Under our conditions Den bracteosum is grown under 70% shade cloth where it is hung high receiving strong air movement. It is grown in bark and perlite and is fertilized once a week at ½ strength with organic or inorganic fertilizer. Regular watering is needed depending on weather conditions so the roots don't try out totally. Reduce watering during the winter months.

## Plants Worth Noting

Once again our monthly meeting had an incredible variety of plants on display.

Due to the multitude of plants on the benches, my task this month was challenging because I had to choose which were my favourite and it would have been quite a lengthy article if I had commented on every single one, therefore I cut it down to my four favourites.

As I made my way around the benches one of the first plants to catch my eye was the Aeranthes grandiflora x arachnites - this was an incredible plant in my opinion because it was sprouting 3 spikes with 2 incredible open blooms and 2 more buds yet to open, no doubt the 3rd spike will form a second bud.

As I proceeded around the benches the next plant to take my fancy was Phragmipedium Green Hornet. This cross was registered in 1996 and is the offspring of Phrag. longifolium x pearcei. This plant was a beautiful little miniature, with a light green pouch and green and pink petals making a surprisingly attractive arrangement of colours that instantly struck my fancy. Due to falling in love with this plant. I recently bought a Phragmipedium pearcei, and I would love to gain some tips from the owner of the plant, because I'm hoping that there will be similarities in culture. One day I may grow mine as well as the one that was at the meeting.

As I made my way over to the species section of the hall, my eye was instantly caught by Eric Locke's Neofinitia falcata. I had never seen a more incredible specimen of this plant in my life; it had a vast multitude of spikes and was absolutely bursting out of its pot. Neofinitia falcata is a miniature plant that likes plenty of airflow around its roots, which is proven by how happy it seemed in the net pot that it was in. This species has a regal history in Japan where was grown by warriors or other high-class people.

As I finally came to the end of the species section my breath was taken away as I finally got around to the magnificent Miltonia candida that I had been looking

forward to inspecting since I had first seen it placed on the bench. If I remember correctly it was mounted on a section of "Gutter Guard" filled with the grower's personal choice of medium. I gave up counting the spikes once I hit twelve because I still had many more spikes to go and the main part of the meeting was about to commence. This plant was truly a pleasure to behold and I wish the grower all the luck with it in the future.
