MOTION TO BE TABLED AT FEBRUARY GENERAL MEETING

BACKGROUND: Members of E.D.O.S Inc. are hereby advised of the intention by the Management Committee (E.D.O.S Inc.) to move the September General Meeting from 8.00 pm on Thursday 25th September 2014 to 1.00 pm on Sunday 28th September 2014.

- (c) Assist Chief Steward to ensure (i) sufficient section class ribbons are available; (ii) sufficient stewards are available on judging night; and (iii) other support to judges on the night; and
- (d) Any other duty which may need to addressed during the course of any show.

Cultural Award January 2014

Dendrobium bracteosum

This epiphyte originates from the lowland forests of Papua New Guinea. This tells me that *bracteosum* likes to grow in warm moist conditions. The plants are quite compact with pseudobulbs up to five hundred millimetres in length. Den *bracteosum* flowers on the mature canes from the previous year. The best part of orchid growing is the anticipation of what is to happen in the future, with regular fertilizer every few days.[Horticulture Solutions] Duett we have already doubled the length of the new growths. Like all dendrobiums they like good air movement - my plant is quite close to the ground and about three meters in

front of the evaporative cooler, this runs for most of the daylight hours. We don't get the southeasterly breeze you people talk about as we live on a hill at Holland Park facing the west. I swear that the breeze we get is straight off the Simpson Desert, not very conducive to orchid growing. After a lot of thought I sealed off the western wall and of course blocked off my main ventilation source, I then installed a ceiling fan which runs in reverse for twenty four hours a day, with under bench misting running for two minutes every hour. Seems like a lot of work for one little plant but I do have a couple of others.

Member Number - Your EDOS Member Number is on the newsletter envelope following your name, or available from the Plant Registrar. This number needs to be used if you are benching and/or selling plants.

Plant Labels - For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct **before** benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have available on Friday night prior to benching of plants, the Orchidwiz database for members to check their labels. Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone

Fire Ant Register – Legislation requires that Members **MUST** sign the Fire Ant Register before Plants can be accepted into the Hall for either showing or Sales.

This Register MUST be signed regardless of where you live. The Hall is in a Fire Ant area so care needs to be taken when transporting plants.

Please remember that **Plants MUST NOT be placed** on the ground or floor at the Hall.

Condition of Sale Plants – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and NOT recently potted. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc.

It has been noted that some plants presented for Sale at recent EDOS Shows were below the standard and quality that this Society considers acceptable. If a plant is not of the standard that you yourself would purchase, then it should not be presented to Plant Sales

As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - in the future such plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables.

Cut Flowers and Greenery – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, especially on Saturday, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements.

Many thanks in advance to all who help us out. If in doubt please ask Brent Nicoll.

Plant of the Month January 2014

PHRAGMIPEDIUM SORCERERS APPRENTICE

This plant is one of the largest Phrags I grow, due to the size I only ever keep one division on the bench.

The parents are longifolium x sargentianum and they have produced a plant with such vigour it is unbelievable. At the moment it has 3 spikes in flower with more spikes developing. Transporting this size plant which is 120cm wide and 135cm height and

increasing daily is a challenge, as invariably it suffers some leaf damage on each trip.

The mix is the same I use for all my plants, $\frac{1}{3}$ bark, $\frac{1}{3}$ jumbo perlite, $\frac{1}{3}$ small coconut chip, watered with only tank water thoroughly each day and with a saucer of water under the pot except in the winter months. Fertilizing is done once a week with whatever I have on hand and I never spray with any preventative fungicides or any other chemicals unless there is a problem. Cinnamon is one of the better problem solvers to have handy and can be used on all plants regardless of size. This plant lives in a dome roofed shade house with 75% green knitted shade cloth.
