#### **BACKGROUND:**

Members of E.D.O.S Inc. are hereby advised of the intention by the Management Committee (E.D.O.S Inc.) to move the July General Meeting from 8.00 pm on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2015 to 8.00 pm on **Thursday 30**<sup>th</sup> **July 2015**.

The purpose of moving the general meeting is due to all the executive members namely The President; Secretary and Treasurer, as well as a number of other committee members and particularly AOC Judges, will be attending the Toowoomba Orchid Society 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Conference and Show which is occurring from Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> to Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2015.

**Plant Tags** will be available at the February and March Meetings from Roy Jope– If you need more Tags

or are unable to attend the meeting to collect please contact John Rooks. Please ensure that you use EDOS sale plant tags only.

**Craft Sales Tags** will be available at the February and March Meetings from Ann Kable.

**Member Number** - Your EDOS Member Number is on the newsletter envelope following your name, or available from the Plant Registrar. This number needs to be used if you are benching and/or selling plants.

**Plant Labels** - For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct **before** benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have available on Friday night prior to benching of plants, the Orchidwiz database for members to check their labels. Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone

**Fire Ant Register** – Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry requires that Members **MUST** sign the Fire Ant Register before Plants can be accepted for either showing or Sales.

This Register MUST be signed regardless of where you live. Although the Hall is no longer in a Fire Ant area care needs to be taken when transporting plants.

Please remember that **Plants MUST NOT be placed** on the ground or floor at the Hall.

**Condition of Sale Plants** – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and NOT recently potted. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc.

It has been noted that some plants presented for Sale at recent EDOS Shows were below the standard and quality that this Society considers acceptable. If a plant is not of the standard that you yourself would purchase, then it should not be presented to Plant Sales

As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - in the future such plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables.

**Cut Flowers and Greenery** – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, especially on Saturday, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements.

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## Cultural Award January 2015

Encyclia Mary Motes x Encyclia Bees' Knees

Plant was purchased about 3 Years ago from Fame Orchids as a small flowering plant. As I do with most purchases it was repotted into my own mix of small bark, jumbo perlite and small charcoal using a 100mm pot. In January 2013 the orchid was repotted into a larger 175 x120 squat pot using medium bark, perlite and charcoal. As this pot is much deeper the bottom of the pot was filled with 25 to 35mm of styrene for better drainage.

This cross is not registered as yet but is made up of 50% *E. alata*, 25% *E. plicata* and 25% *E. diuana* 

This orchid is grown with all my *Cattleyas* on benches in a large shade house with solar weave and shade mesh on the roof at total 60% shade and shade mesh at 50% shade on the sides. The solar weave allows for watering to be controlled.

Generally this orchid is watered ever 3 days in summer and about once per week in winter. This depends on how hot or how cold the weather has been. I supplement this watering with misting, especially in hot weather and regularly water under the benches to help cool and increase humidity.

When watering or fertilising I make sure to water the top of each pot and water until water or fertiliser runs through the pot.

This orchid is fertilised all year round alternating between foliar feeding and deep water fertilising using Horticultural solutions HSO 12 and HSO 22. Deep water fertilising occurs every second week year round alternating between the High Nitrogen and Low Nitrogen fertilisers. With foliar feeding the same products are used adding Hy-san at 5ml per litre and Amino K at 1ml per litre. This is sprayed over the foliage on alternate fortnights to deep water fertilising.

The orchid house, due to solar weave on a gable roof, is generally 2 to 3 degrees warmer during the day. This is a great benefit during winter months. To circulate this heat there are 4 small fans continually operating during daylight hours.

## Plants Worth Noting January Meeting

A quick look around the benches, and a couple of plants caught my eye. The first was Bulb. frostii with two clog like flowers on the end of a short inflorescence, flowers were a spotted burgundy and cream in colour. A number of our members commented on how the flowers looked like a pair of boots. Bulb. frostii is endemic to Vietnam and can be found in Thailand, and the Malay Peninsula. A small, rather creeping epiphyte with growths to about 5 cm tall that may be somewhat clustered or spaced up to 2.5 cm apart along a fairly thick rhizome. The lateral inflorescence is produced from the base of the pseudobulb and extends outward in a more or less horizontal or slightly descending position. Flowers are carried in a cluster at the apex of the spike with 1-3 per inflorescence. Bulb. frostii grows in shaded to dappled light in cool to warm conditions

The second plant that caught my eye was *Catasetum [Ctsm.]* (Blood Stone x Kay Lowe) x *Ctsm.* (*cristatum* x Penang). This plant looked like a young plant with one inflorescence and three yellow/green flowers on the end, *Catasetums* generally flower from the base of the pseudobulb. They can be a little difficult to grow as the need a definite dry period when the leaves turn brown and drop off. Don't water for about 5 Months, and when the new pseudobulbs start to appear is the time to start watering ensuring that no water is left in the top of the new growth.
