If you are unsure of the correctness of any of your labels, EDOS has Orchidwiz available at Monthly Meetings and Shows for any member to check the names of plants.

Remember, the EDOS Inc Spring Show is only 2 months away, so now is a good time to start thinking about what plants you may have for showing, and start working on staking those plants (according to EDOS General Rules of course) and checking those labels.

Plants Worth Noting

Den. Warringah (speciosum x bigibbum) - an unusual cross given the different flowering seasons of its parents. Bigibbum size white flowers with pointed sepals and petals. The pink stripe on the centre of all the petals and sepals really made this plant stand out.

Phrag. Caroline Miller OH was a real stand out in the any other genera section. A large and well grown plant sporting a deep red flower not typically seen in this genera.

Australian natives are a favourite of mine so I couldn't go past Bulb. shepherdii. Happily growing on a mount and flowered well even if you did need a magnifying glass to really appreciate the flowers. Definitely not a plant to try to grow in a pot due to its overall small size.

The deep purple tubular flowers of Den. goldschmiditianum drew me to this plant as the one I have has only flowered once since I bought it. Flowers are produced along the length of the pseudobulbs and not from the apex as is typical in most Dendrobium hybrids.
