Cultural Award May 15

Sophronitis cernua (photo on back page)

Described by Lindley in 1828 as the type for the species.

First examples of *cernua* were collected by William Harrison, a Brazilian merchant from Liverpool who sent them to his relative in Liverpool in 1826. He collected *cernua* from trees growing where the city of Rio de Janerio is now located. The species is fairly wide spread in S.E. Brazil, found on trees and rock in coastal lowlands and inland savannah, at a latitude and location similar to Brisbane, making it a splendid addition to local collections.

I acquired my *Soph. cernua* In June 2011 from Easy Orchids mounted on a small piece of coarse tree fern where it appeared happy enough. In September 2012 I mounted the plant and small mount onto a large piece of red tree fern where it remains.

This year it has produced thirteen healthy new growths sequentially over a period of 2months with on average 5 flowers per inflorescence which was a pleasant improvement on last year's four growths with nine flowers and a resounding testament to more attention being paid to the providing of nutrients in a form that allows the roots to absorb them and endeavouring to maintain a media that is PH neutral.

I house my *cernua* along with all my plants in a modest 4 x 3 m shade house covered in winter and summer with 50 and 70% shade cloth respectively plus solar weave covering the roof and about 80% of the side area which gives good air flow as the enclosure is in a fairly exposed position. *Soph, cernua's* only special treatment is to be hung on the southern wall under a top shelf where it gets a little more shade and a bit less air flow. I believe nutrition is very important in cultivating healthy orchids, and I feed *Soph. cernua* with the best I can obtain. I use a NPK 15:3:12 fertilizer (including trace elements) that contains only nitrogen in its simplest form, nitrogen nitrate which is immediately available to the plants and formulations containing urea are avoided.

As my Soph. cernua is mounted, I water it every day in summer and every 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} day in winter, as I do for most of my mounted plants.

I water with tank water and fertilize all my Cattleyas with a nutrient solution of PH of 6.5 and an EC of 250ppm every 7 days in summer decreasing to 10 days in winter and increasing the duration in inclement weather both winter and summer. I also give a monthly feed of SeaSol combined with the fertilizer. On especially hot days I water daily.
