Plant of the Month - May 19

Cycnoches warscewiczii 'Fiona'

Hailing from South America this beautiful orchid always gives an eye catching show when flowering.

Housing: It is grown under 50% shade cloth on the sides and roof, it also has Solarweave plastic on the roof so I can keep it dry in winter. There is a 40cm fan which runs 24/7 to help with air circulation

Potting Media: Is a small layer of bark in the base of the pot, then sphagnum moss to the top of the pot.

Watering: In summer I water every 2nd day and in winter not at all. Spring watering does not commence until the new shoot is well up and the new leaves are opened up. If you water before this it will rot the new shoot as water will sit in the whorl. In autumn watering is reduced as the leaves start to brown off.

Fertiliser: When repotting Catasetinae I put a dose of Plantacote fertiliser half way up the pot, then another dose at the top with a little bit of sphagnum moss over it to stop the Plantacote washing out. Fertilising is also done every week using Duet for 3 weeks then on the fourth week I use a mix of 50% Seasol and 50% Powerfeed. In winter they are not fertilised at all.

Pests: They are prone to spider mite attack and scale. They are sprayed in summer every month with Eco-oil. This I find controls any pest problems.

Catasetinae are very rewarding as they are very fast growing and always spectacular when flowering. Also, you get a break in winter where they require no work at all except picking up the dead leaves as they fall. I repot in winter as the new shoot in spring is very easily knocked off when repotting.
