Lycaste aromatica

This is a very common species found in and around Mexico, growing in damp forests on trees and rocks at heights from 500 feet to as high as 6,000 feet.

This plant has grown in this pot for several years, is watered at least twice a week and fertilised once a week. It grows high in the orchid house under an open 75% shadecloth.

This species has achieved dozens of awards worldwide with some plants having hundreds of flowers, so mine with 55 flowers has a long way to go.
