Plants Worth Noting

There was such a variety on the Benches at the September meeting that it was hard to choose.

There was everything from the "Tried and True" *Cattleya* Lynn Spencer 'Cha' to novelty of the very small *Bulbo. bracteatum.*

C. Lynn Spencer 'Cha' was registered in 1964, a cross between C. Bob Betts and C. White Blossom. C. Lyn Spencer 'Cha' was awarded an AM in 1985, and is still seen around the benches regularly. It still ticks all the boxes as a benchworthy plant.

Bulbo. bracteatum is a small epiphyte found in SE Qld/NE NSW. It was originally registered in 1891. This very small brown and yellow flower has at this stage not been awarded, but with the popularity of these Australian natives growing, one would assume that it will only be a matter of time.

Another species on the bench at the September meeting was *Den. linguiforme*. This plant comes from NSW/QLD/New Caledonia, and has over the years been awarded 35 times. It is really spectacular when grown mounted, and allowed to grow into a specimen. One of these plants won Specimen of the Show at the recent EDOS Inc. Spring Show. This plant has had many names over the years, including *Dockrillia linguiforme*, *Dockrillia nigentii*, *Den. nugentii*, *Callista linguiformis*, and its current name *Den. linguiforme*. How confusing can this be?

Cultural Notes September 15

Gastrophaius (Gp.) Microburst

Cross is Gastrorchis pulchra x Phaius tankervilleae

This terrestrial family of orchids are very easy to grow, but a little extra care and attention to their needs will increase their beauty. They need bright light but avoid direct sunlight, they need lots of water but not wet feet. When the flowers fade you need to give the plant special treatment as the new growths emerge and you remove the dying flower stalks, you need to also remove all the old leaves. Wait until the new growths are about six inches high and cut off all the old growth even if the leaves are in perfect condition. The old growths will rarely flower again as the flowers will come from the new growths. A multi growth plant can easily be divided or you can cut the flower stems into pieces with a viable node on each cutting and place them partly covered on a bed of sand or sphagnum and you will produce new plants from about 25% of the cuttings.

I grow this plant under 75% shade cloth and fertilise once a week. To my mind this is a beautiful flower when viewed in natural daylight. It has just a hint of mauve and green tonings to compliment the overall ivory colouration.
