Members Growing Competition

At our September meeting the Committee will be distributing seedling Phalaenopsis plants donated by Graham McKay, and deflasked by Eric Locke, (and looked after by Barry since deflasking) to attending members, as part of a New Growing Competition. The object of this "Competition" is to see who can get their plant to flower first, with everyone starting as close to equal as possible.

What will happen! As members sign in at the September meeting, numbers will be given out to the first 35 EDOS members/families. As there are limited numbers of plants, one only per family/membership will be available.

These numbers will correspond with numbers on the plants, which will then be handed out at the Red Spotters Club. Make sure that you arrive early remember – you need to be in it to win it!!!

Details on the judging criteria will be released in future newsletters.

Cultural Notes

Restrepia Contora

This genus is a member of the Pleurothallis alliance, the genus is named after Don Jose Restrepo, a Colombian naturalist. There are 40 or so species and are found from Southern Mexico to Bolivia, most are found in Ecuador and Colombia where they grow at 1500-3500m in mossy habitats, generally near streams. I acquired about 6 plants of this genus from Easy Orchids about a year ago. These plants do not like hot dry days, so I grow them on a low weld mesh shelf about 300mm from

the ground with under bench sprinklers that come on for 30 seconds 3 times a day in summer, with 2 layers 50% shade cloth till end of April, then I remove 1 layer and move the plants up to next shelf at about 900mm till end of September. My plants are grown in sphagnum moss. The fine roots prefer a constantly moist but not soggy mix. These orchids can be grown by cutting off a leaf with about 3cm of stem, pot up in a small tube filled with sphagnum moss, burying the leaf and stem to the base of the leaf, using older flowered leaves and stem is best. In a few months the leaf will (or should) develop a tiny plantlet growth which should flower in a year or two
