**Plant Sales** – Our Plant Sales Convenor Alan McKell is looking for assistance in Plant Sales. If you are available to help out, please either see Alan or a Committee member, or put your name on the Roster.

**Plant Sales and Benching Tags** –Plant Sale and Plant Benching Tags will be available at the September EDOS meeting from **Roy Jope.** Benching tags are also available for printing from the EDOS website – www.edos.org.au.

Please ensure that you use EDOS sale plant tags only. If you are unable to collect them at the meeting please contact Plant Sales Convenor Alan McKell.

**Craft Tags** – Craft Tags will be available at the September EDOS meeting from Ann Kable. If you are unable to collect them at the meeting please contact Treasurer John Rooks.

**Plant Labels** - It is very important when benching plants that labels are easy to read and correct. A clearly written label makes it much easier for everyone to read, and avoids the possibility of a plant being given an incorrect name on the Prize Cards and in Competition Results, or even placed in the incorrect category.

For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct **before** benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have available on Friday night prior to benching of plants, the Orchidwiz database for members to check their labels. Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone.

**Member Number** - Your Member Number is on the newsletter envelope following your name, or available from the Plant Registrar. This number needs to be used if you are benching and/or selling plants.

**Show Attendance Register** - It is E.D.O.S Inc. policy that **ALL** persons attending; exhibiting; benching or selling orchid plants at the Spring Show sign the E.D.O.S Inc. Attendance Register, so please make sure you sign when you arrive at the Hall.

**Attendance Book** – for Insurance Purposes it is necessary for Members to sign the Attendance Book when helping out at the Show

**Cut Flowers and Greenery** – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, especially on Saturday, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements. Many thanks in advance to all who help us out. If in doubt please ask Brent Nicoll.

**Condition of Sale Plants** – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and NOT recently potted. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc. If it is not a plant in the condition you would consider purchasing yourself, then please do not put it up for sale!

As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables.

#### Plants Worth Noting

Oeoniella polystachys



When I saw this plant arriving at the last meeting I thought it looked like one of the Madagascan orchids that seem to do well at our place in our growing conditions. Sure enough, a little research confirmed that this member of the Angraecinae sub tribe does in fact inhabit Madagascar and all three island chains that surround it

Speaking to the owner, Garry Shishkin, he stated 'it grows like a weed' and this is backed up everywhere in research. He confirmed that the flowers last 3-4 weeks and have a nocturnal fragrance. Garry purchased it from The Strawberry Farm a couple of years ago as a very small plant. It is now approximately 45cm high. He grows it in a shade house and it receives a general water and fertilizer regime. Garry believes spotting on the leaves could have been avoided had it been grown under cover during winter.

In its native habitat, *Oeoniella polystachys* grows primarily on trees in close proximity to the seashore where there is high humidity and considerable warmth. It has a vine like growth habit with its stems and root system surrounding the tree trunk and branches on which it perches.

I look forward to seeing this plant become a specimen in just a few years and in the meantime I will be on the lookout myself to buy what seems like an easy rewarding plant.


