# Cultural Notes August 18

#### **Dendrobium** Balnarring

Plant was purchased many years ago from Australian Orchid Nursery as a small seedling plant. As I do with most purchases it was repotted into my own mix of

small bark, jumbo perlite and small charcoal using a 100mm pot. Plant is currently growing in a 120mm squat pot using small bark, perlite and charcoal. These *Dendrobium* Australian Native Hybrids do not mind growing a little pot bound.

Dendrobium Balnarring is a cross between Den. Starsheen and Den. speciosum. Den. Starsheen is mainly made up of Den. tetragonum and Den kingianum with trace amount of other Australian Native orchids

This orchid is grown hung high in a large shade house with solar weave and shade mesh on the roof at total 60% shade and shade mesh at 50% shade on the sides. The solar weave allows for watering to be controlled.

Generally this orchid is watered every 3 days in summer and about once per week in winter. This depends on how hot or how cold the weather has been. I supplement this watering with misting, especially in hot weather and regularly water under the benches to help cool and increase humidity.

When watering or fertilising, I make sure to water the top of each pot and water until water or fertiliser runs through the pot.

This orchid is fertilised all year round alternating between Horticultural solutions HSO 12 and HSO 22. Deep water fertilising occurs every week all year round alternating between the High Nitrogen and Low Nitrogen fertilisers.

The orchid house, due to solar weave on a gable roof, is generally 2 to 3 degrees warmer during the day than the ambient temperature. This is a great benefit during winter months. I use 4 small fans continually operating during daylight hours to circulate this heat and reduce the heat in the gable roof. This also gives great air circulation which is critical to good growth of orchids.
