

#### **NEXT GENERAL MEETING**

Following on from the Management Committee decision in March, there will not be a General Meeting in June, due to the continuation of the Covid-19 lockdown.

We want to keep everyone safe and protected from this virus, so we will be re-assessing the situation around July, possibly at the next Committee Meeting.

As the Government eases the restrictions, we will look at what we will be allowed to do, of course all dependant on the availability of the Church hall.

As we have been doing for the past few months, if there is any important information to be distributed to the members, it will be emailed out to everyone.

#### **NEXT COMMITTEE MEETING**

The Management Committee is looking at holding a Committee Meeting in July - the date is yet to be finalised, due to the availability of Committee Members. In the meantime, the Executive Committee are attending to any matters that require immediate attention. Because most things have shut down, there has not been much happening.



A decision will be made in July whether EDOS goes ahead with the Spring Show on 19 and 20 September. This decision will depend on the Government Restrictions that are in force, the availability of the venue, and will also be dependent on whether the AOC makes a decision to allow the AOC Judges to return to judging. Once again, these decisions are all made to keep our members safe and healthy.

As soon as a decision is made, we will notify everyone to allow for plenty of time to prepare for the Show.
