#### **NEXT GENERAL MEETING**

The next General Meeting will be held on Thursday 22 July, 2021, commencing at 8.00 pm, at the Bayside Uniting Church Hall, 420 Wondall Road, Manly West.

In order for the Committee to have Signs, Registers, Sanitisation Stations, etc in place for Covid requirements, we ask that members DON'T arrive before 7 pm unless you are coming to assist with setup.

As we are operating under the Uniting Church's Covid Plan, please be aware of some of the Instructions which will be enforced. These Rules may change, depending on Government changes being passed on by the Church.

- Firstly, and most importantly, if you are not feeling well, or show any of the flu-like symptoms, please do not attend the meeting.
- Entry will be via the usual door, however to Exit the Hall you will need to use the double sliding door (Fire Exit Door). Both doors will be signed appropriately.
- Condition of Entry The Queensland Government have changed the Requirements for compulsory signing in at events, and it is now compulsory, where possible, to use the "Check in Qld" Code,

- so please make sure that you have your mobile phone with you. This code will be inside on the Reception table for use by those with suitable phones. For those members who do not have a suitable phone, there will be an alternative Register to complete. It will now also be back to our usual system of signing the regular Attendance Book as
- Please observe the 1.5 metre distancing Rule.
- Hand Sanitising and Cleaning Wipes will be available at designated stations for members' use.

### 55th EDOS Inc SPRING SHOW

The Committee is moving ahead with plans for the 55<sup>th</sup> Spring Show on 11 and 12 September, 2021.

The Show Schedule is attached to this Newsletter, and is also available on the Website.

We will be using the same layout as our very successful Autumn Show which covers the COVID19 Rules.

If there is any member who is interested in Sponsoring a Category at the Show, please let Show Captain, Ray know.

For those members who have not sold through EDOS Inc before, EDOS Inc makes payments for Plant Sales via EFT. Treasurer Rooks will have forms available at the next few meetings and at the Show for Members to fill out with Bank Details. These forms, once filled out, are to be handed back to either John Rooks, or Dot Rooks who is one of the Hostesses on the door at Meeting nights. Be assured that this information will remain confidential.

### BAR CODE LABELS

Bar Coding Labels for the upcoming EDOS Inc Spring Show will need to be ordered early to avoid a last minute rush.

It may not be possible to print labels on Friday night.

Remember, any labels that you had left over from previous Shows can be used again at the Spring Show.

The Bar Code Label Request Form is on the Website, and for those who need them, they will also be available at the July and August meetings.

The contact details on the form are Important, so that Ray can contact the member if there is an issue, or to let the member know when they are ready for collection.

The most important information required is the number of labels required for each dollar value (whole dollars ONLY). Any labels you do not use can be used at any EDOS Inc show in the future.

To ensure that the Barcoding system works efficiently and quickly, we are requesting that ALL labels be put vertically on the pot (as below), instead of horizontally, to enable the reader to work more efficiently.





The Barcode label needs to be put on the back of the plant name tag or a separate tag on mounted plants.

Remember, it is a requirement to have these barcode labels on your pots, as this is the only method our Plant Sales Staff will be using to process the sale of your plants.

In addition to the bar code labels, you can still put the "old style" information Tags on your plants with any other information you want eg species, colour etc.



Plant Benching Labels - are available on the Website. They will also be available at the July and August Meetings. Suggestion: If you can, fill them out on line before you print them off – this makes it very easy for the Scribes on the night of the Show.

**Craft Sales Tags** will be available at the July and August Meetings. If you have any queries about items to be sold through Craft Sales, please contact Convenor Narelle Edmonds.

**Member Number** – If you do not know what your Member Number is, it will be available from the Plant Registrar on the Friday night. This number needs to be

used if you are benching, otherwise we can't identify the owner of the plant should it win.



For any members who are unsure of, or would like to confirm that their plant labels are correct before benching, (either spelling or registration of crosses) EDOS will have the Orchidwiz database available for members to check their labels on Friday night prior to benching of plants, Please see Ann Kable or Janelle Girdlestone.

**Show Attendance Register** - – It is EDOS Inc. policy that ALL persons attending; exhibiting; benching or selling orchid plants at the Autumn Show sign the EDOS Inc Attendance Register, so please make sure you sign when you arrive at the Hall. **This is in addition to the Covid Sign-in.** 

**Fire Ant Register** – Department of Agriculture and Fisheries requires that Members MUST sign the Fire Ant Register before Plants can be accepted for either showing or Sales. This Register MUST be signed regardless of where you live. Care needs to be taken when transporting plants.

Please remember that Plants SHOULD NOT be placed on the ground or floor at the Venue.



**Kitchen** - Catering Convenor Margaret would appreciate assistance in the kitchen, especially early in the day for preparation.



**Cut Flowers and Greenery** – The Ladies from the Floral Arrangement section of our show are requesting contributions of any orchid flowers, bromeliad flowers and

Anthuriums, and also greenery for their floral arrangements, <u>especially on Saturday</u>, as these Floral Arrangements are very popular, and supplies usually run low by lunchtime.

The leaves from the cordylines, flax, anthurium, camellia bush, magnolia, strap leaves and crotons are great for greenery, along with all the others you kindly bring. We would also be very grateful for containers (small or large) suitable for flower arrangements.

Many thanks in advance to all who help us out. If in doubt please ask Brent Nicoll.

#### Other General Information

- Members of other societies who are benching plants for judging are permitted to offer plants for sale (2 good quality plants required to be benched to do so), subject to the normal conditions of sale and volume.
- All plants are the owners' responsibility, and need to be collected after completion of the show. The

Committee is not responsible for any plants not collected.

**Plant sales** – Convenor Dick Dorham will require helpers in Plant Sales. Dick would also appreciate it if anyone can bring in small boxes.

If anyone is interested in operating the Cash Registers during the Show, please contact Plant Sales Convenor, Dick at the next meeting, and he will organise some training. This is even more important now, as we will be operating 3 tills for our Shows in future. One of these will be Cash Only.

Convenor Dick would also like to emphasise that fact that you must NOT alter the monetary value on the bar code label by writing on it. If you wish to change the value, or you don't have a label of the value you want to charge, please replace the label with the correct value. You cannot put 2 labels on your plant to be added together (for example, a \$20 and a \$10 label for a \$30 plant)

**Condition of Sale Plants** – Please ensure that any plants you may present for sale are virus free, clean and <u>NOT RECENTLY POTTED</u>. Plants need to be stable in the pots and not show any insect damage, etc.

It has been noted that some plants presented for Sale at recent EDOS Shows were below the standard and quality that this Society considers acceptable. If a plant is not of the standard that you yourself would purchase, then it should not be presented to Plant Sales
As per our By-Laws, -refer in particular to EDOS By-Laws 5.6 and 5.7 - such plants which are deemed to be of an unsuitable standard will be removed from the Sales Tables.

Sales at EDOS Inc Shows are limited to Orchids and Orchid related products. Any queries relating to Sales need to be directed to the Plant Sales Convenor, Dick

### Assistance During The Show

If you are available to help out at the Autumn Show please put your name on the Roster which will be at the next couple of meetings (Roster will be at the front table), or contact either Show Captain Ray, Secretary Garth or President Barry and let them know when and where you would be available to help out.

One area we urgently need volunteers to cover is scribing on Friday night during Judging. It is not an onerous job, the main part of the job is copying names off the plant labels of the plants that have been judged as winners, along with the correct Class, so that those in the office can print out the Place Cards. There will be someone there to assist you during the night. (Incidentally, you could always "practice" on Meeting

nights during judging, just speak to Ken Haase before the meeting starts).

We particularly need volunteers for the Front Door, and Plant Minding, and to set up on <u>Friday afternoon from 3.00 pm.</u> and especially for the clean up on Sunday afternoon. Because of the Covid Rules, there will be a bit more cleaning to do than usual, so the more helpers we have the quicker it all gets done!

under the current Covid climate, we understand that some members will be reluctant to attend a public event such as this, but if you are able to, please consider helping out. Even if you can only spare a couple of hours, we need as many members as possible to help make the show a success and give all of our workers a break and a chance to have a browse around the show! Remember, it is your Society.

# Cultural Award June Meeting

#### Dendrochilum javieri

This vivid golden yellow *Dendrochilum* is endemic to the Philippines where it grows in its natural habitat above 1000 metres. Under my conditions *Ddc. javieri* is grown under 70% shadecloth in bark and perlite (2 parts bark – 1 part perlite) where it receives good air flow and high humidity. During the summer months it is watered regularly not allowing the medium to totally dry out. In my opinion this helps to reduce leaf tip die back. Watering in winter is minimal. Fertilising is done with ½ strength organic or inorganic fertiliser weekly.

This is truly a beautiful orchid and deserves to be in everyone's collection.

Editor's Note: this orchid is now known as Ddc. javieriense
