Cultural Award October 2021

Paph. Mary Franz Smith

This Paph had ten very large strong flowers that have been flowering for more than eight weeks. The cross being the species of *Paph. glaucophyllum* and Paph. Saint Swithin.

This orchid was awarded an Award of Merit and went through to win Orchid of the Year 2013 by the owner Reg McIlwain. I obtained a piece of this plant about 5 years ago and I struggled like Reg to bring it to flower.

I will now let you know it is not really a secret, the idea has been around for longer than me. All I did was sprinkle a little dolomite and blood and bone mixed on top of each pot. This can be done in the spring and again in the autumn. You only need about 10 grams otherwise you could clog up the potting mix. With all the wildlife on our roof I stopped using my water tank and have gone back to town water. This ages for as long as I can to help evaporate the chlorine. This is done in one of those big blue drums to which I add Peters 20-20-20 fertiliser at 100 grams every time I water.

When to water has always been a big decision, I overcame this by growing most of my plants in those small clear drink containers which I make small holes in them. This works well by looking to see the dampness in the pot. The only problem with that is little Greta Thunberg has had them banned.

Sometimes I think we lose our way with all the sprays etc for our plants when there is another old remedy that works. I have not used a fungicide in years. I spray with pool algaecide at one ml per litre. I apply this with one of those click on spray containers you can buy at Bunnings - the ones that have premix like seasol in them. In one litre of water I add 20 ml of the algaecide this makes 20 litres, so I spray the plants, the roof, the walls, everything. The Paphs especially can get a lot of brown spots, this in time will be eradicated. Once a month is fine, it takes about five minutes.

Bunnings Sausage Sizzle Benefits Australian Orchid Foundation


