Bulbophyllum makoyanum

Bulb. makoyanum is an epiphyte which comes from the Philippines, Borneo and Malaysia where it grows on trunks and major branches of forest trees.

Under my conditions, it is grown on a tree fern mount under 70% shadecloth approx. 1.5 metres from the gravel floor where it receives good air circulation. This

species likes high humidity and loves misting in the early morning and late afternoon in summer. During winter reduce watering. A variety of fertilisers both organic and inorganic are applied at ½ strength weekly.

This *Bulbophyllum* is a worthy plant to have in your collection.
