CHANGE TO EDOS INC BY-LAWS FOR 2024

The Committee of EDOS Inc have made a change to the By-Laws, to come into effect on 1 January, 2024.

The change is as follows:

CHANGE FROM:

11.4 Novice growers will remain in the Novice section until the member has accumulated 20 points, or for a maximum of 2 years. Members can go up to Open upon accumulating the points, or wait until they have completed the 2 years. A member may elect to go into the Open section at any time.

CHANGE TO:

Novice growers will remain in the Novice section until the member has accumulated 30 points, or for a maximum of 2 (two) years, **whichever comes first**. A member may elect to go into the Open section at any time.

Cultural Award October 2023

Tolu. Capalaba Sun 'Yellow'

Tolumnia's come from the Caribbean Islands and mostly flower in October/November.

I acquired my plant in January 2012 and it has never been repotted. It is grown in bark in a 70mL basket under 50% green shadecloth with solarwave on the roof and 50% shadecloth on the walls.

It is hanging at head height facing north with reasonable air flow. Watering and foliar fertilizing (with various fertilizers) is done weekly in summer and less often during winter.

My Tolu's are misted every second day in summer and every four days in the cooler months. I also have underbench sprinklers that come on three times a day for 20 seconds to keep up humidity.

The plant put on quite a display with 19 sprays this year. I have found Tolu's easy to grow in various ways, such as on mounts and in 50mm tubes, and with different mixes. So give them a try as they don't take up much space and are rewarding with their kaleidoscope of colours.
