Dinema polybulbon

Dinema polybulbon is native to Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean as a miniature epiphyte which grows in the humid mixed forests at elevations of 600-3200 metres.

This species likes high humidity and loves misting in the early morning and late afternoon in Summer. It is grown on a tree fern mount under 70% shadecloth where it receives good air circulation. During the winter months watering is reduced. A variety of fertilisers organic or nonorganic is applied at half strength weekly all year round.

Dinema polybulbon is a worthy plant to have in your collection.
